RESTRICTIONS Children under 16 years of age are allowed on working parties only if accompanied by a parent or person acting <i>in loco parentis</i> . It must be made clear to the accompanying adult that the children remain their responsibility.

MONITORING At the start of the working party, when the safe procedures for working and the safe use of tools is explained, the warden should check that any adults accompanying children are paying attention and can therefore be reasonably expected to supervise and control the activity of the children, deciding which equipment is safe for each child to use.
